Steps to be Taken in Case Material is Released or Spilled Recover free liquid, for recovery or disposal: Add inert absorbent (sand, earth, sawdust, etc.) to spill area and shovel into containers for disposal. LARGE SPILL : Dike to contain - vacuum pump into containers marked for recovery.	
Avoid discharge into natural water courses. Product is slippery under foot, flush smooth surfaces thoroughly. Mop up, rinse with water.
